TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Welcome to our TENTH Annual Spring Classic Tournament! Please take some time to look over this important tournament information – this is all pertinent information vital to the success of this event. We rely on the cooperation of coaches, players, and fans in ensuring that all facility rules and regulations are followed. Please make sure that all persons involved in your team are familiar with all of the rules. We hope you enjoy yourselves this weekend.

EACH SITE IN THE TOURNAMENT HAS ITS OWN RULES FOR FOOD AND DRINK: COOLERS MUST BE KEPT OUTSIDE AT ALL SITES

- **Bothell & Inglemoor High Schools:** Capped water bottles and sports drinks will be allowed in the gym. All coolers, bags, etc. must be kept out of the lobby area, or under the mezzanine outside.
- **Northshore School District Junior Highs (Canyon Park & Skyview):** No food, or drink of any kind allowed in the gyms. This includes water bottles. There will be a cafeteria adjacent to the gym for players to keep their bags, coolers, food, and drink. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- **Bellevue Community College:** No food or drink allowed in the gym. Capped water bottles are acceptable, but not flavored water. You can bring your own chairs, but chairs are not allowed on the floor without carpeting. Please do not block any exits with bags, equipment, or chairs in the lobby or the gym.
- **Interlake High School:** The gym manager will review gym rules with teams at the pre-tournament meeting each morning.

GYM RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Gym managers will have meetings at the beginning of play at your facility to give specific rules on their facility. We ask the coaches cooperation in enforcing the rules. It is very important that you inform your players, parents, guests, and coaches of these rules – especially those regarding food and drink in the gyms. We have lost many facilities due to the failure to follow these rules. **THE FUTURE OF THE TOURNAMENT DEPENDS ON YOUR COOPERATION!**

1. Outside chairs (beach chairs) may be restricted at several sites.
2. Hallways must remain clear of coolers, chairs, blankets, bags, etc. – this is a fire regulation.

PENALTIES FOR FOOD / DRINK RULES VIOLATIONS

Penalties for each violation of the above stated rules will be as follows: **13 points for a game to 25, 8 points for a game to 15.** The penalty will be assessed at the start of their next scheduled game. Any person associated with a club or team can be held responsible for a violation. We cannot and will not lose these great facilities for future use due to cooler and food violations.

GAME AND FORFEIT TIMES

Please note that matches may begin before the scheduled time. Matches will begin 10 minutes following the conclusion of the previous match (exception: first round of the playoff brackets). Once the captain's meeting has taken place (during the 2 minutes of shared peppering), warm-up will be as follows: 4 minutes court time for the serving team, then 4 minutes court time for the receiving team, serving will be done during your four minutes. In order to prevent any potential injuries **there will be no shared hitting.** Matches will run ahead of schedule if possible. Teams competing for the first time each day will start their matches no earlier than the scheduled time. Forfeits for the first game will be 10 minutes following the conclusion of the previous match. Game 2 will be forfeited 15 minutes from the forfeit of game 1.

OFFICIATING

Team officiating responsibilities are listed in this manual and posted at your tournament site. First round playoff matches are highlighted in the bracket. In the remaining elimination matches, in most cases the Losing team will have officiating duties for the next scheduled match on that court. Each team is responsible to provide the following: 1 first official, 1 second official, 2 lines persons 1 official scorekeeper, 1 score flipper, and 1 *libero* tracker. Players may serve as R1 DURING POOL PLAY ONLY, AND THE COACH MUST BE THEIR R2. Regardless of who is officiating, a coach must be courtside at all times during the team's officiating assignments. **Penalties for being late to or missing an officiating assignment: If you are late to your assignment, you will be penalized one point per minute you are late, up to a full match (50 minutes).** If you miss an officiating assignment you will be penalized one match AND be assigned to officiate the next scheduled match that your team is not playing. If you are late to or miss the last match assignment for the day, the same penalty will be assessed on the next day's competition. Officiating assignments are clearly determined throughout the tournament handbook, so there should be no missed officiating assignments. Common courtesy dictates that teams not leave before officiating after their final match / loss on the final day of competition. Tournament directors, when given a choice (two teams assigned to one match), will release teams on Sunday night that have a long trip home.

RULES OF PLAY

2007 USAV rules will be in effect. All matches in pool play and playoffs will be played 2 of 3 to 25, rally scoring games as per USAV rules. During Pool Play, Games 1 and 2 will be capped at 27. All 3rd games will go to 15 with no cap, switching sides at 8; the winning team must win by 2 points. Teams will have 3 options at the coin toss: serve, receive, choice of court. There will be no caps in playoffs.

PROTEST PROCEDURE

If a protest is to be filed it must be done at the time of the incident, no later. Only the floor captain may file a protest (In the U14's a coach may file). The protest must be written on the score sheet by the scorer or the official and must be signed by both the floor captain and the referee. A protest committee will be designated at each site, each day, during the pre-tournament coaches meeting. The protest must be ruled upon before the game can continue. **A protest cannot be filed at the end of a match.** Judgment calls are not protestable.

SEEDING AND TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding for the tournament was done based on tournament results and placing in at Puget Sound Region and neighboring region events – no seeding system is ever perfect, and some changes were made to avoid club or region conflicts. In order to simplify the tournament your progressive placing throughout the tournament will be based upon your seed and your finish within your pool; not on how your performance in pool compares to other teams in other pools. This format is similar to that used in USAV Qualifiers and Junior Nationals. This will make it simpler for coaches, fans, players, etc. to figure out exactly where they play next without having to wait for other pools to finish in order to place themselves within the next pool or playoff bracket.

There will be no playoff sets to settle ties. Tie-breaking procedures will be as follows:

- Two-way tie (by match record):
 - 1) Head to head MATCH
- Three-way tie (by match record):
 - 1) Set Record (sets won vs. sets lost = win percentage)
 - 2) Overall positive points among the tied teams
 - 3) If still tied, Overall positive points in the pool
 - 4) If still tied, coin flip (based on pool seed: 2vs2, winner vs. 1)

NOTE: For three-way ties, this formula will be used to seed the teams 1, 2, 3.

Again, there will be no playoff matches; all ties will be broken by the above criteria.

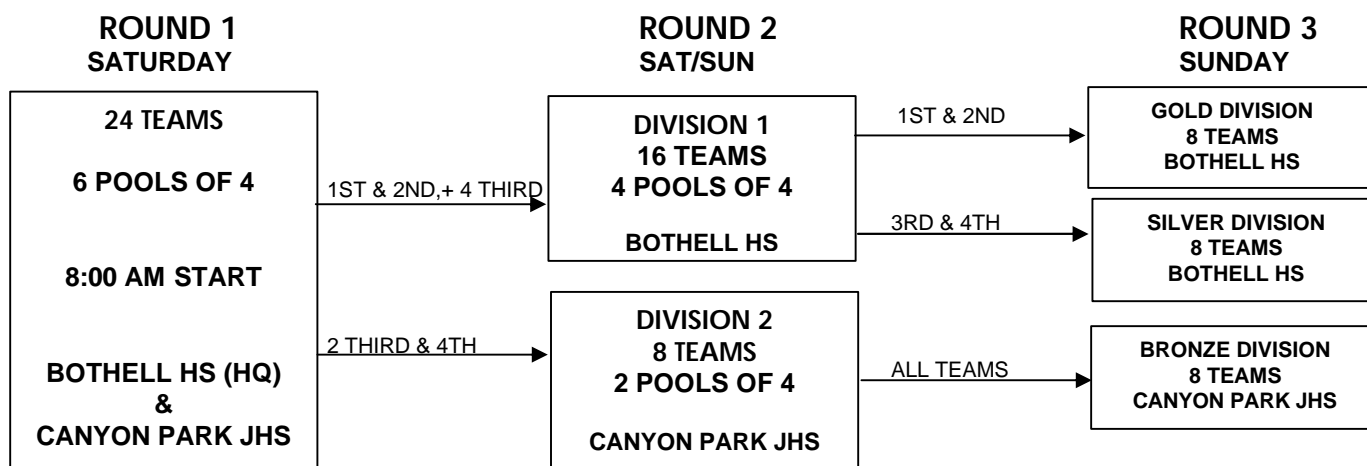

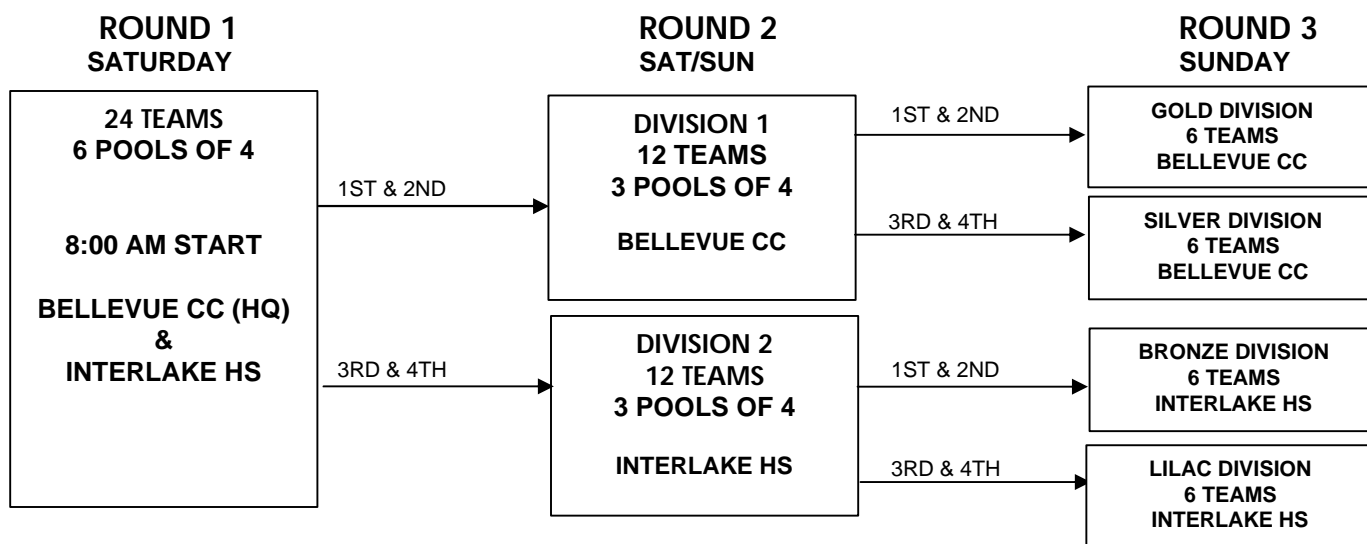

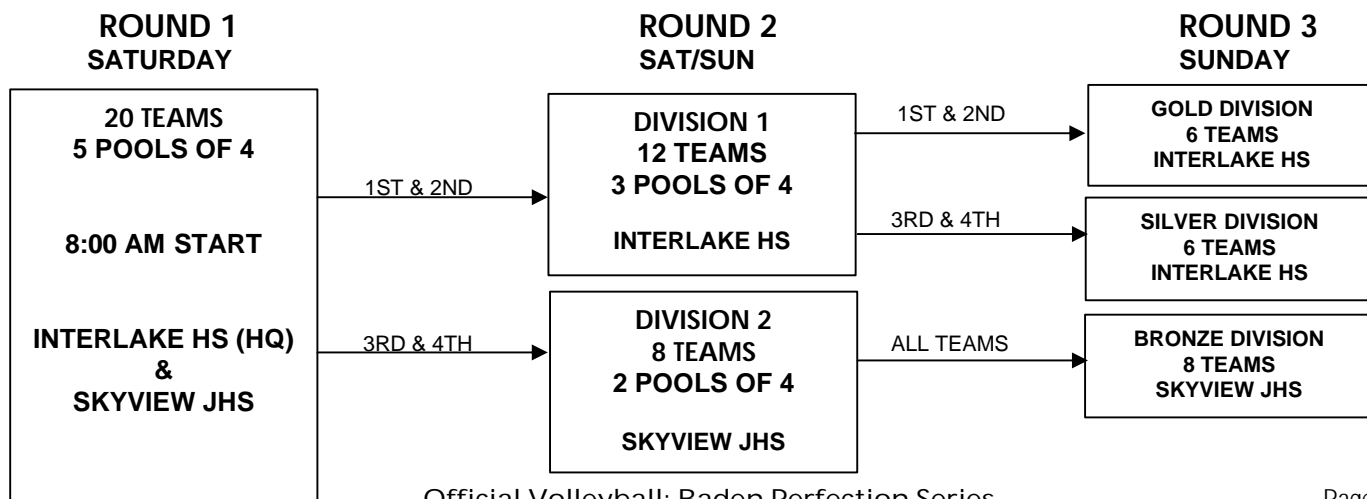
18 UNDER TOURNAMENT -- FLOWCHART

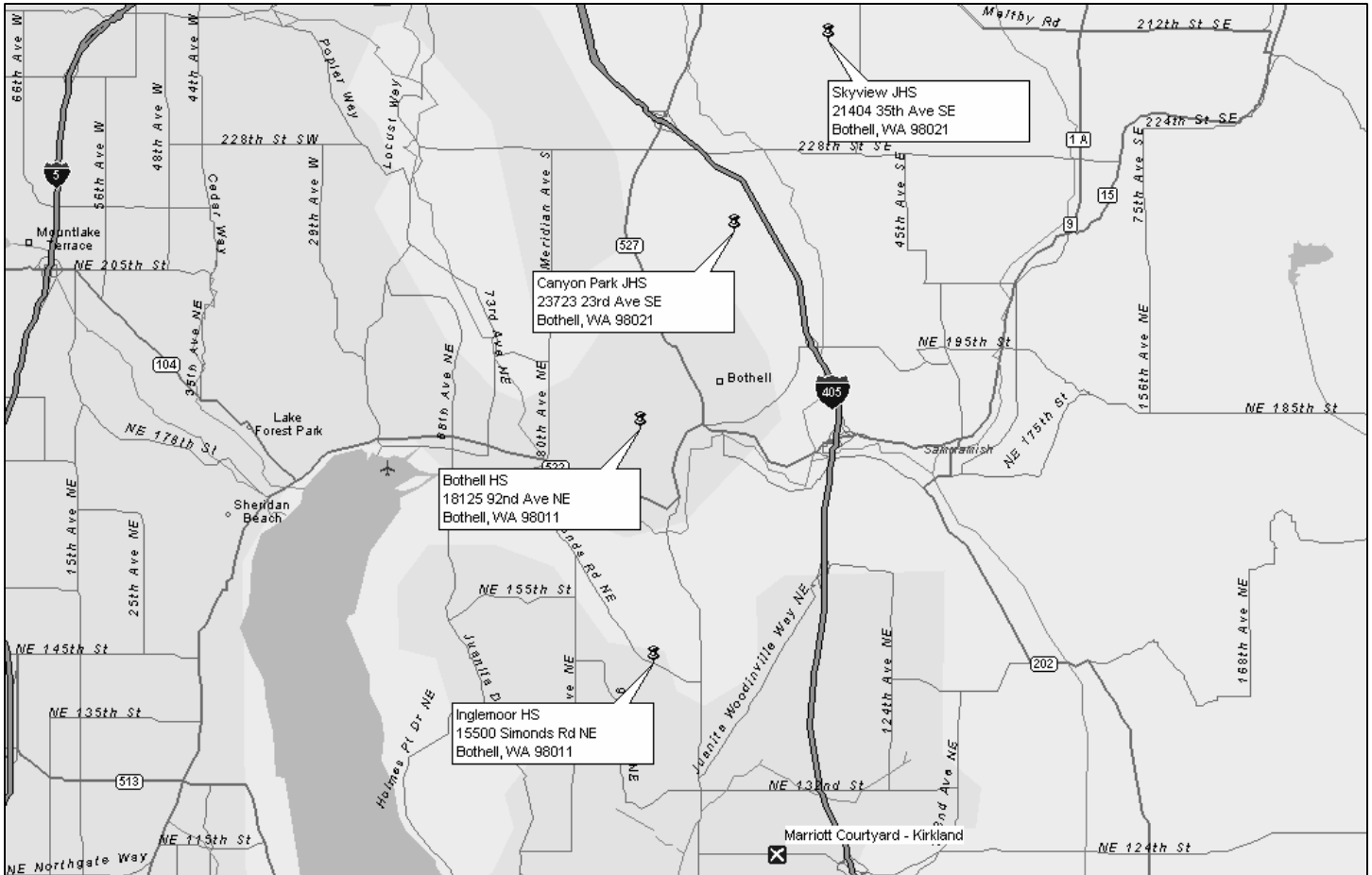

DIRECTIONS TO PLAYING SITES



Bothell High School & Canyon Park Junior High School

Bothell High School

Coming from North or South on I-405

Exit 23 Westbound (SR 522/Bothell). Ramp will join SR 522 Westbound, which becomes Bothell Way N.E.

Turn Right at N.E. 180th Street

Turn Right onto 92nd Avenue N.E.

Bothell High will be on your left

Coming from Southbound I-405

Exit 26 (Bothell-Everett Highway)

Turn Right onto Bothell-Everett Highway

Turn Right at N.E. 188th Street

Turn Left at 92nd Avenue N.E.

Bothell High will be on your right, approximately a half mile after turning onto 92nd Avenue N.E.

Coming From Lake City/Bothell Way

Drive East through Kenmore

Turn Left onto 91st Avenue N.E.

Bothell High will be on your left at the top of the hill

Canyon Park Junior High School

Coming from North or South on I-405:

Take Exit 26 (SR 527/Bothell-Everett Highway)

If Northbound, turn Left onto Bothell-Everett Highway

If Southbound, turn Right onto Bothell-Everett Highway

Turn left onto 228th Street S.E. (heading East)

Turn Right at the second light onto 19th Avenue S.E.

Take the first Left onto 232nd Avenue S.E.

232nd Avenue S.E. will curve and become 23rd Avenue S.E.

Continue up hill. Canyon Park Junior High will be at your left

Coming from Lake City/Bothell Way:

Traveling East on Lake City Way, it becomes Bothell Way N.E.

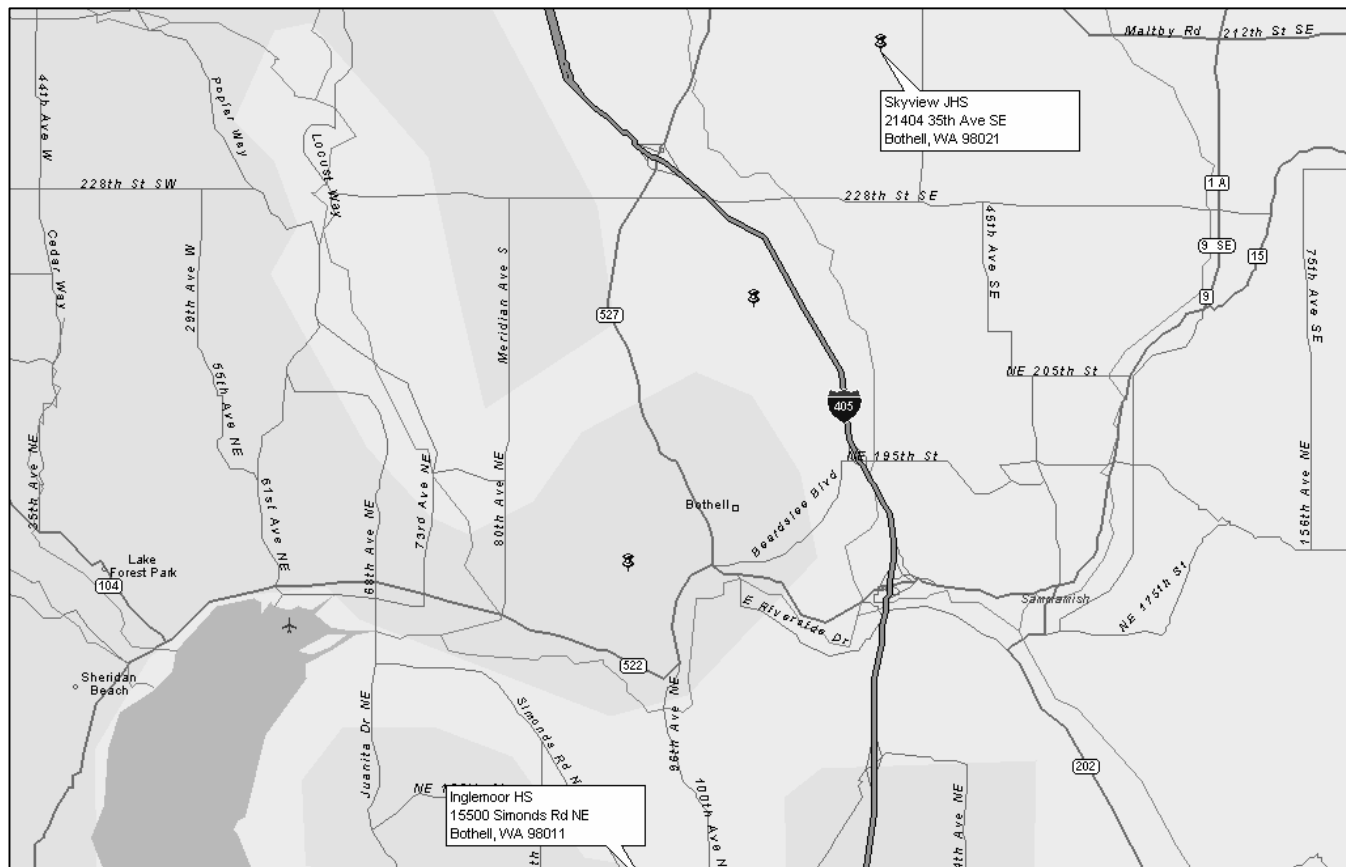
Proceed to the main intersection in downtown Bothell (SR 527/Bothell-Everett Highway)

Drive straight through this light (street becomes Main Street)

Turn Left onto 104th Ave N.E. (road will become 23rd Avenue S.E. after crossing the King-Snohomish County Line)

Continue on this road and Canyon Park Junior High will be on your right

Inglemoor High School:

Heading North or South on I-405:

Take Exit #22 (N.E. 160th Street) from I-405. From the South, take a Left onto N.E. 160th Street. From the North, take a Right onto N.E. 160th Street. N.E. 160th Street turns into Juanita-Woodinville Way N.E. Turn Right onto N.E. 145th Street. Turn Left onto 100th Avenue N.E. Turn Right onto Simonds Road. After approximately one mile, Inglemoor High School will be on your right.

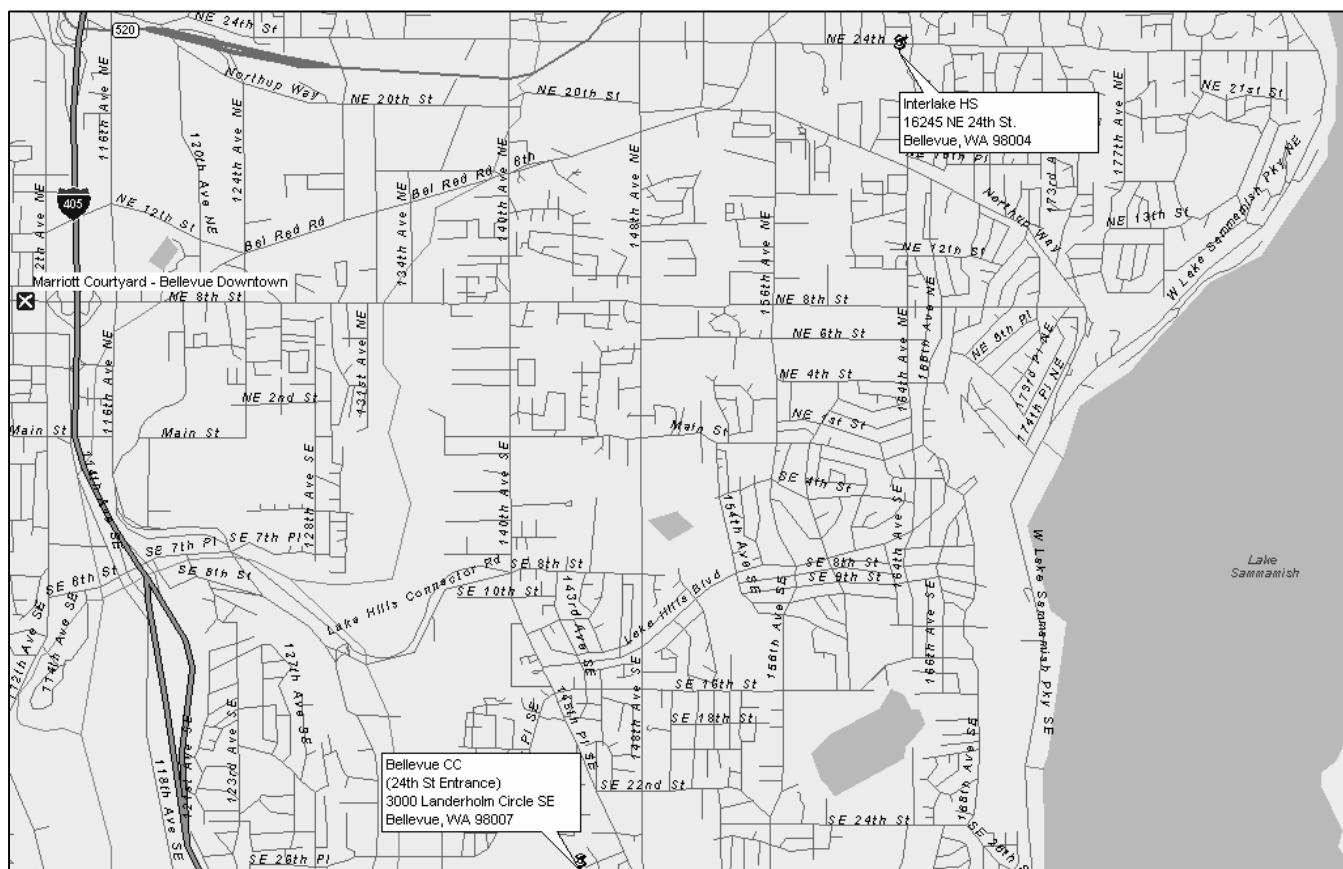
Skyview Junior High School

Coming North or South on I-405:

Take Exit 26 (SR 527/Bothell-Everett Highway).
 If Northbound, turn Left onto Bothell-Everett Highway.
 If Southbound, turn Right onto Bothell-Everett Highway.
 Turn left onto 228th Street S.E. (heading East).
 Proceed East through two stop lights, under I-405 and across a small valley to the base of a hill.
 Turn Left onto 31st Avenue S.E. The road will curve around and bring you up onto a plateau and eventually become 5th Avenue S.E.
 Skyview Junior High will be on your left.

Coming from Lake City/Bothell Way N.E.:
 Turn left at Bothell's main intersection (SR 522/Bothell Way and SR 527/Bothell-Everett Highway).
 Continue North on Bothell Way and turn Right at 228th Street S.E.
 Proceed East through two stop lights, under I-405 and across a small valley to the base of a hill.
 Turn Left onto 31st Avenue S.E. The road will curve around and bring you up onto a plateau and eventually become 35th Avenue S.E.
 Skyview Junior High will be on your left.

Bellevue Community College -- Directions to North Entrance

From I-90 Eastbound:

Take Exit 11B (148th Ave. S.E.). Turn left on SE 24th street and follow the signs to BCC's North entrance.

Once on campus, you will see the baseball field, continue past the baseball field, the gym is adjacent to the baseball field on your right

From I-90 Westbound:

Take Exit 11. After exiting, stay left and follow signs onto 156th Ave. SE. At the stoplight, turn left onto Eastgate Way. Move into the right lane and turn right at 150th Ave. SE. Drive up the hill and merge onto 148th Ave. SE. Turn left on SE 24th street and follow the signs to BCC's North entrance.

From I-405 Heading North or South:

Follow signs to the Spokane I-90 Interchange (eastbound). Take Exit 11B (148th Ave. S.E.). Turn left on SE 24th street and follow the signs to BCC's North entrance.

Interlake High School

From SR-520 Redmond:

Take 148th Ave NE exit (going south).

From the left lane on 148th, turn left at NE 24th at stop light.

Go 1 mile on 24th, past Unigard Insurance Complex.

Turn Right at IHS entrance off 24th across from 161st Ave. NE.

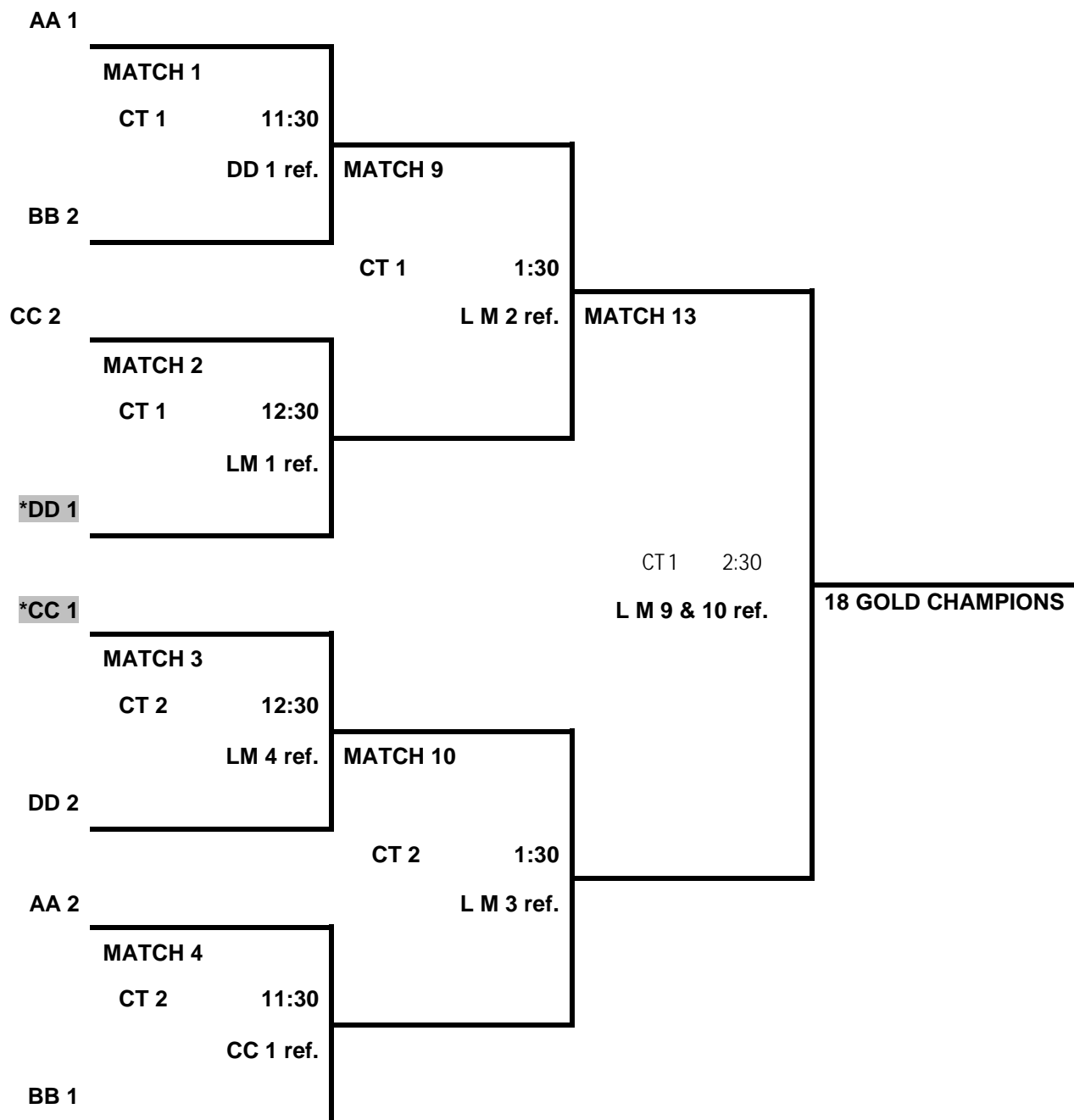
For Playoffs:

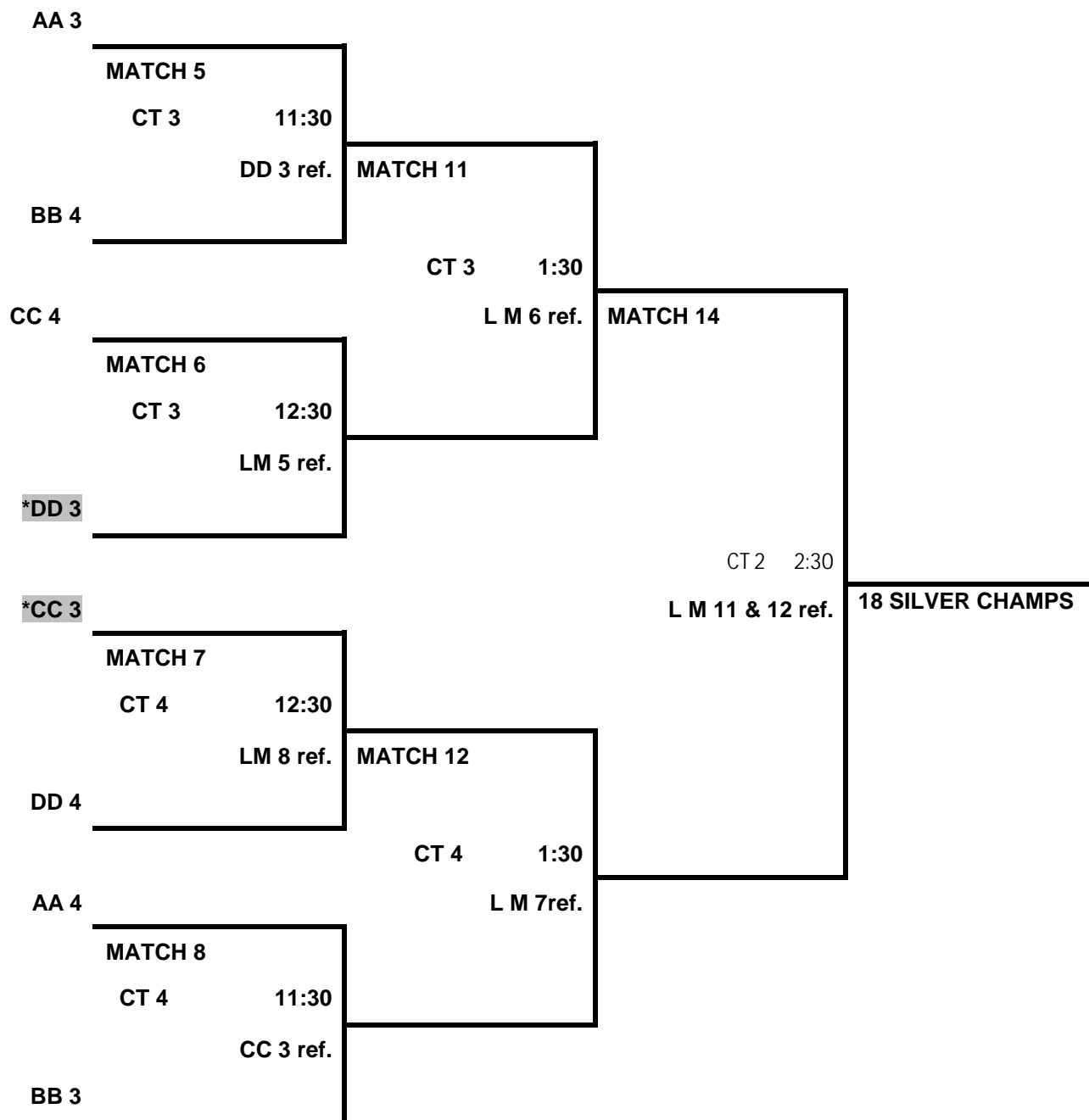
GOLD DIVISION PLAYOFFS: BOTHELL HIGH SCHOOL, COURTS 1 & 2

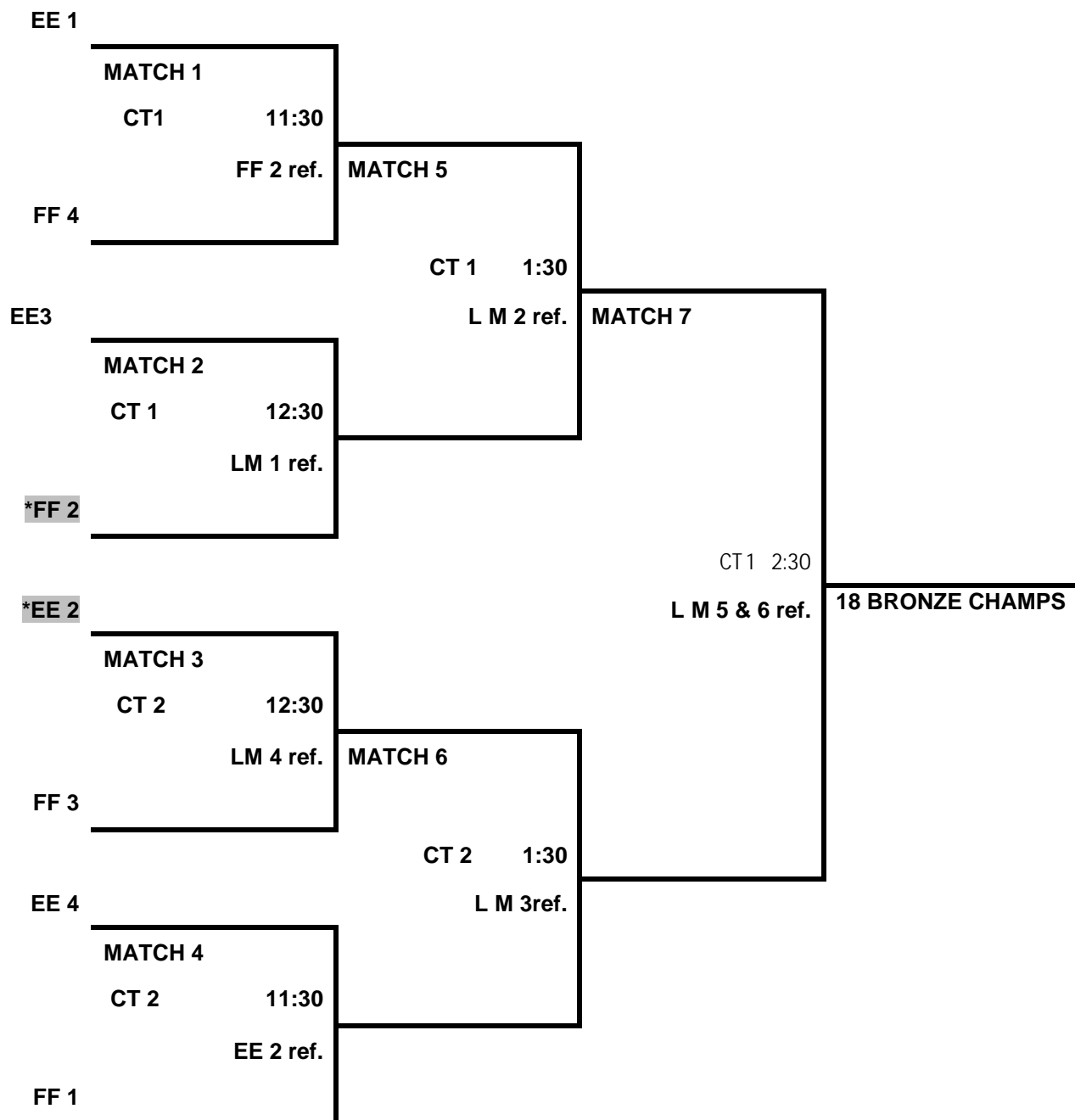
