The Small Print:

For some special events entry fee is increased to cover event shirts and/or Cash prizes.

All participants must be registered with AVPNext to participate in our events. Membership is \$20. To save time, a form can be downloaded from our website; you can also register the morning of the tournament.

Combined Divisions or divisions with 24 or more teams will be split after pool play

TOURNAMENT POLICIES

- Tournaments begin at 9:00 am sharp.
- Check-in begins at 8:00 am; you must be checked-in at the Event Site by 8:45 AM.
- For tournaments where tees are given out-- you will get one tee-shirt per weekend, even if you play twice.
- You may lose your spot in the tournament if you check-in after 8:45
- No Refunds for late arrivals.
- If you are under 18 your parent or guardian must sign your AVPNext Membership Form.
- If it is raining: You must show up at the tournament, check-in, and be prepared to play.
- We virtually never cancel an event. If we do, it will be posted on our homepage at www.volleyballnw.com
- Sand tournaments are not canceled because of rain.
- In the highly unlikely event that we do cancel an event due because of Mother Nature, credits will be given to future events.
- If you enter by phone, fax, or E-Mail and chose not to show up you will lose those privileges for the rest of the season.
- The office closes at 1 PM on Fridays (Thursday for WENATCHEE). You will reach our answering machine after that time.
- No Phone/Fax/E-Mail Entries will be accepted after NOON on Fridays (Thursday for out of town tournaments).
- You may enter On-Site at the Event ONLY if space allows
- Walk-up registration includes a \$10 per team late fee. Select tournaments have early entry deadlines to aid in logistical preparation.

LEVELS

AA = Open Highest level of Skill.
 A = Well skilled, can sideout very consistently
 BB = Can serve consistently, and can bump, set, spike
 A/BB = Intermediate
 B/Rec = Bump, set, spike on an inconsistent basis
If you place in the top two at two or more tournaments, you must move up a level.
